With the help of cyclists like you, over \$26,500 has been raised in the past 16 years for the hike/bike trail around Hastings. With the recent addition of a 3.1-mile section, the Pioneer Spirit Trail is now an 8.9-mile continuous trail system connecting residential areas to shopping districts and schools with recreational areas.

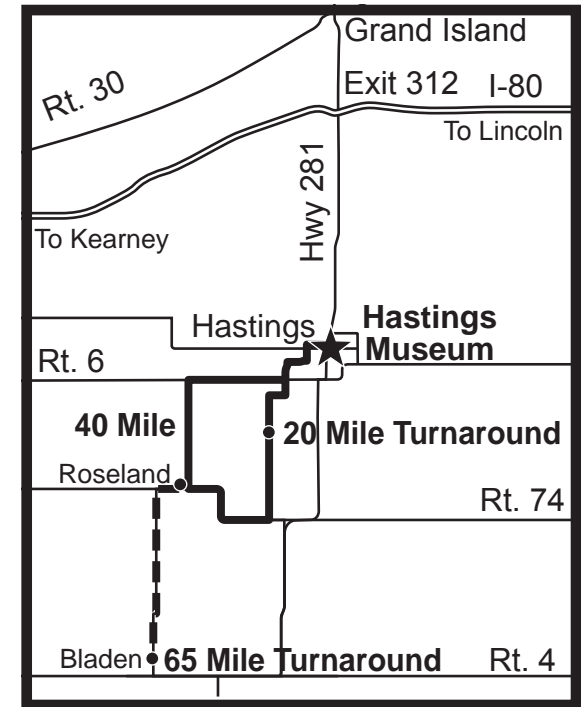

How to Get Here

Take Exit 312 from I-80. Turn South on Hwy 281 for about 16 miles. Turn Left (East) on 14th Street. Go two blocks and turn Right (South) on Hastings Ave. Go South and take the second left into the Hastings Utilities parking lot and park there. Registration is at the shelter in Highland Park across the street. Everyone must go through registration to sign the release form!

After the Ride

Showers are available after the ride at the Hastings YMCA on 16th Street. Join us at Valentino's of Hastings for an after-ride meal. Additional meals may be purchased for your family and friends who may not have participated in the ride.

Safety

Helmets are required. Roads are open to traffic, so please obey all traffic and safety rules. All riders must sign a waiver at registration. Riders under 18 years old must have a parent or guardian sign their waiver.
